HYDROTHERAPY

Our hydrotherapist uses our underwater treadmill to offer your pet relief for a wide variety of conditions. Hydrotherapy provides minimal to zero impact exercise which can help with the effects of aging, weight loss and may enhance a pet's range of motion, balance, mobility, and flexibility. It also helps to reduce anxiety and build confidence. Hydrotherapy aids in strengthening your dog's muscles and can help improve your dog's gait. The duration of therapy, the water level, treadmill speed, and overall activity will be customized to the needs of your dog.

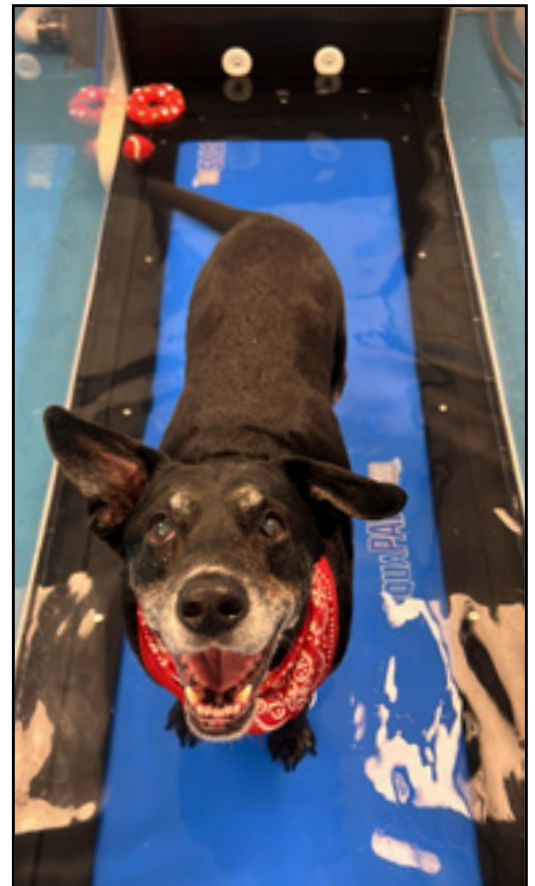
FLOAT THERAPY

Whether your dog is nervous around new people or experiences generalized anxiety, this anti-anxiety massage aims to create a serene and nurturing environment, fostering both physical and emotional well-being for our canine companions. The massage focuses on specific stress-relief points, employing a soothing touch to alleviate tension and induce a deep sense of relaxation. Tailored to meet the unique needs of each dog, this therapeutic session combines canine massage with calming aromatherapy, and music therapy. This massage is up to 45 minutes. ADD COLD LASER for more relaxation.

ANXIETY RELIEF “FLOAT” WATER THERAPY Canine Float and Massage in the Water Your pup is cradled in the arms of our hydrotherapist in this warm water “float” relaxing the mind and body. Swaying motions aid relaxation in this anti-anxiety-focused session. If your dog likes to walk or swim we have the option to use the underwater treadmill to work off anxiety. The 30-minute session includes up to 25 minutes of water activity.

ANXIETY RELIEF MASSAGE & “FLOAT” WATER THERAPY

Combining canine massage therapy with hydrotherapy, this anti-anxiety session is ideal for dogs facing various anxiety types. It includes stress-relief points, therapeutic touch, and relaxation through massage, customized for your dog’s needs. Following the massage, your dog may enjoy a “Float” session as described above.



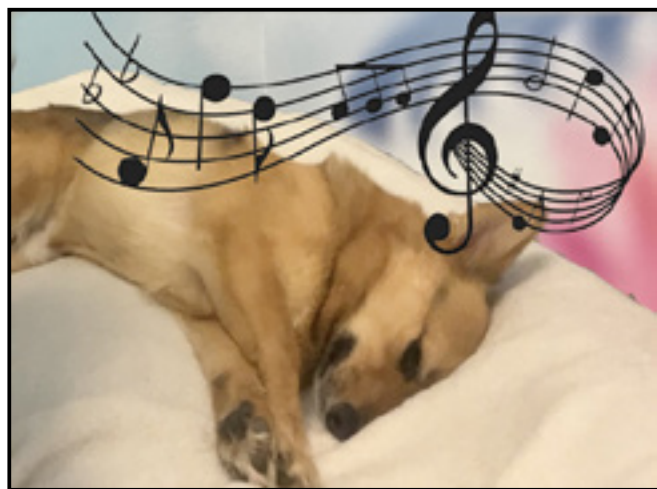

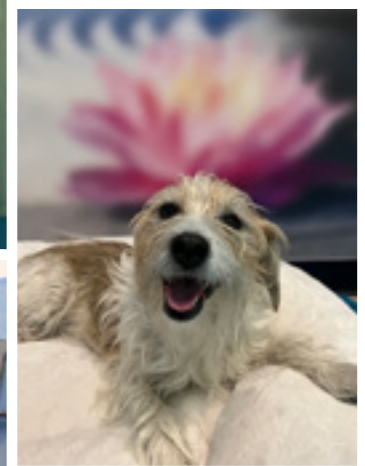
